RIDING LESSON RULES

All forms/waivers must be signed and payments made prior to service. A 24-hour cancellation notice is required. Rescheduling is first come first serve basis. There are no refunds. \$35.00 fee for cancelled checks. **TACK:** Clean and check tack before and after riding. Put all equipment away after use. Only use equipment that is approved by instructor/horse owner. **HORSE:** Groom before and after riding. Horse should be warmed up before lesson (15 minutes). Cool horse out after lesson (15 minutes, or until animal is dry). **BARN:** Clean area before/after riding. Remove manure from arenas after riding **ATTIRE:** Rider should wear fitted clothes. Boots, or shoes, must have at least 1/2 inch heel. Boots are required. No open toe or tennis shoes. Hard hats are required for all riders under 18 years of age.

General Barn Rules

- No unsupervised jumping, or riding in halters
- Lead haltered horse with lead rope and no riding in aisle ways.
- Crossties should be unhooked when passing through.
- No glass containers are allowed in stable area and no smoking, alcohol at any time
- No night riding and or double riding and shoes must be on at all times at the barn
- Do not handle, or touch other people's horses

•All horses must be current on shots/coggins.
